EVENT INFORMATION

ENTRY FEE:

First 180 entries receive a fantastic **EVENT HAND-OUT**.

Availability of goodie bags & event hand-out cannot be guaranteed for late entries.

HISTORY:

The Pete Marlin Surfski Race is an annual downwind race, held in honour of the late Pete Marlin, who lost his life on the Umkomaas River in 1988 and covers approximately 23km which allows a bigger section of the paddling fraternity to participate. This year, the race has again been selected to host the SA SURFSKI CHAMPS! With this all in mind, the Border Canoe Club and people of East London look forward to hosting you and your families for what promises to be an exciting event.

ACCEPTANCE:

On payment, however no cheques or telephonic entries will be accepted.

Any paddler may enter if he/she has passed the Surfski Proficiency Test (RPT), has equivalent paddling experience and is also a **registered and paid up member of an affiliated canoe club and the CSA**.

SAFETY REQUIREMENTS:

- The written acknowledgement by his/her club safety officer that he/she is competent to paddle in open ocean races if and where required.
- The wearing of a **PFD** (CSA approved). It must be bright in colour (preferably lumo).
- A **leash** in sound working order, and must be attached to the body and to a safe point on the craft, preferably the foot strap.
- The **CSA number** of the paddler of the craft to be affixed to the craft on either side of the front deck.
- A **cell phone** with enough airtime, a fully charged battery, the race emergency number loaded, in a waterproof pouch, housed in a pocket of the PFD, per paddler.
- A **tracking** device or application (NSRI SafeTRX, Endomondo) approved by race organisers. Device needs to be housed in a pocket of the PFD, and may not be attached to the craft. If the tracking device is incorporated within the cell phone, then only one device will need to be carried, per paddler.
- A **whistle**. Of the variety that can operate while wet.
- Brightly **colored clothing**, including a cap (if worn), preferably lumo.
- A minimum of 30% of the deck of the ski must be covered in a bright colored paint or a bright colored (preferably luminous) decal. Or, 1000mm of the nose and tail of the ski must be painted a bright colour.
We would like to see at least a portion of the tip and tail in a bright colour, right around, if possible.
- A **bright colored decal** on the back of each blade of the paddle.

THE RACE SAFETY COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO STOP A PADDLER FROM PADDLING THE RACE, SHOULD WE DEEM THIS PADDLER NOT SUFFICIENTLY PROFICIENT OR EXPERIENCED FOR THE PREVAILING CONDITIONS.

NATIONAL SEA RESCUE INSTITUTE: SAFETRX smart phone app

RSA SafeTrx allows you to plan your journey on your smartphone. Directly from your smartphone you can enter your journey details and know that your journey is being tracked. Should you not return by the time given, your 'emergency contact' will be alerted via sms and advised to alert the Maritime Rescue Co-Ordination Centre (MRCC).

The NSRI will marshal the safety for the race.

Life Savers will marshal the surf zone.

Ambulance and Paramedics at the start and end locations.

CATEGORIES:

Prize money will be allocated as per the table below and your age on 1 January 2018 will prescribe your age category.

RACE RULES:

1. Personal advertising will be permitted as per the Canoe SA personal advertising rule.
2. Personal advertising may not clash with the main sponsors.
3. All surfskis/paddles must display any sponsor's logo stickers that are supplied.
4. Stickers other than sponsor stickers will not be permitted in the area in front of the pedals to the nose of your ski.
5. Paddlers must display correct CSA numbers on surfski - incorrect/incomplete numbers will result in disqualification.
6. Any competitor who rides the wake of a motorised craft will be disqualified.
7. Competitors will be allowed seconds to assist them on the beach, but should take care not to infringe on the rules of the race by assisting competitors in the water.
8. Any competitor who receives physical support or assistance or who enters one of the rescue craft, will be disqualified, with the exception of those doing so to repair their craft.
9. The race referee may decide whether or not a competitor should be prevented from continuing the race at any time. The decision of the race referee is final.
10. A safety mobile phone number for emergencies, as well as for notifying the race referee of withdrawals is 083 447 1500. The onus is on the competitor to notify the race referee of his/her withdrawal. The costs of any search resulting from a competitor not notifying the organisers of his or her withdrawal will be borne by the competitor.
11. The finish will be between two wobblies/flags on the beach.
12. Paddlers must cross the finish line with their craft.
13. Double skis – Both competitors must be with the craft.
14. Competitors must finish the race with the craft they started the race in. Paddles may be changed.
15. **The race committee reserves the right to swap days (singles / doubles) in the interest of safety and/or more favorable down wind conditions.**
16. No refund (or any other compensation of whatsoever nature will in any circumstances be made to a paddler who is not permitted for safety reasons to participate, or in circumstances where the race is cancelled

Friday evening at the EL Surf Lifesaving Club at Nahoon Beach from 17h30 to 20h00.

Race & safety briefing will be held each day at the "START LOCATION" unless stated otherwise via (SMS) – please ensure that your correct cell phone number is provided to ensure you receive these notifications.

A social will take place at the EL Surf Club on Friday evening.
